WELSH WELCOME

Hurst House on the Marsh in south-west Wales has a terrific sense of space, both inside and out. From its bar, there's a sweeping vista to a glass-roofed restaurant. This in turn opens onto a sleek terrace, artfully dressed in terracotta, wicker and linen. Beyond the garden is nothing much more than sky. Just outside Laugharne, where Dylan Thomas wrote *Under Milk Wood*, the 18-room hotel is within easy reach of the beaches of Tenby and Saundersfoot. This summer sees the unveiling of four refurbished main-house rooms, converted outbuildings providing 14 mezzanine suites, plus a spa and pool. Prices start at £265 per room per night. SIGHTS FOR SORE EYES

Enjoy spectacular views, from the sleek terraces of Hurst House on the Marsh, right and far right, to the dazzling deco-inspired interior of the St Moritz, below and below right



BEAUTY AND THE BEACH

Miami's South Beach comes to one of the best bays in north Cornwall this summer with the arrival of the St Moritz Hotel, so called because this dazzling white structure stands on the site of a renowned 1930s predecessor that trained its chefs in Switzerland. Now rebuilt as a modern homage to the deco period, the lower floors offer double rooms or sea-view suites with a private balcony, with apartments for rent above. In a separate building, an atrium houses a lobby peppered with antique furniture, plus a Cowshed spa. A sweeping staircase leads to a champagne bar, drinks terrace and restaurant, where chef Elliott Ketley, fresh off the plane from Soho House New York, presides over an open kitchen.
