ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Beaches and Bays

GREENAWAY BEACH (0.1 m)

Perfect for rock pooling. Head down the path from the hotel towards the sea and the beach can be found at the foot of the hill.

DAYMER BAY (0.6m)

Follow the coastal path from the hotel to this deep sandy cove on the estuary. Good parking, WC, and seasonal cafe.

ROCK (1.7m)

A long stretch of sandy beach which is within walking PORT GAVERNE (8m) distance of the hotel. Also catch the ferry to Padstow Limited parking, but easily Cornwall's quaintest cove. from here!

POLZEATH (0.9m)

From the hotel walk the coastal path to this sandy surfing beach. Lots of activities! Parking, WC, RNLI,

LUNDY BAY (2.5m)

Park at the National Trust carpark & stroll to this hidden gem. A slight scramble over rocks to get onto the beach, but worth it!

HAWKER'S COVE & HARBOUR COVE (3.5 m by ferry & foot)

Wide sandy beach great for a walk from Padstow. Old lifeboat slipway and a small hamlet.

PORT QUIN (4m)

Once a thriving fishing village, this historical cove & hamlet is now owned by the National Trust.

Excellent for rock pooling.

TREBARWITH STRAND (13m)

Some rocks to negotiate on route to the sandy beach. Stunning location, often used for filming. Eateries & a couple of shops.
